

1.First, make a bat or spider shape with the tin foil and then use masking tape to make the model more secure. (You could buy a paper mâché bat or spider and skip these next steps and go straight onto the painting).

2.Next, start to wrap the shape with the strips of paper using lots of glue.

3.Continue adding the paper strips until all the foil is covered.4.While the glue is still wet, reshape the model until you are happy with how it looks.

5.Leave your model to dry.

6.Once dry, paint your model.

For a final touch - use some glow in the dark paint to give a really spooky effect.


